





## Cybersecurity

#### What ASD saw

Answered over **36,700** calls to the Australian Cyber Security Hotline, up 12%

on average, 100 calls per day, an increase from 90 calls per day

Average self-reported cost of cybercrime per report for businesses, down 8% overall

- small business: **\$49,600** (up 8%)
- medium business: **\$62,800** (down 35%)
- large business: \$63,600 (down 11%)

Received over **87,400** cybercrime reports, **down 7%** 

on average a report every 6 minutes, consistent with last year

#### Top 3 self-reported cybercrime types for business

- email compromise (20%)
- online banking fraud (13%)
- business email compromise fraud resulting in financial loss (13%)


Almost \$84 million in losses due to business email compromise were self-reported to ReportCyber. Business email compromise continues to significantly impact businesses, with an average financial loss of over \$55,000 for each confirmed incident

11% of all incidents responded to included ransomware, a 3% increase from last year


